#### INTERNATIONAL STUDENT INFORMATION

Our program welcomes many international students each year and we are always excited to see more students apply.

Students who have been accepted and need a Visa, will be given documents to fill out to apply for an F-1 Visa from USC.

Students who already have a valid Visa to study in the USA (F-1 from another US school, J-1, O-1, E-2) may apply to our program under their current Visa. If accepted, a letter will be sent out listing the documents that are required.

#### MINOR STUDENT INFORMATION

Minimum age to be admitted into the program is 16 **by the start of the program.** If the student is turning 18 by the start of the program, they need to apply as adult.

#### HOUSING

Adult Housing: USC student housing will be made available for anyone attending the program.

Minor Housing: Minor students housing is secured by the Summer Program office for all accepted students needing accommodations. The Minor dorm is supervised by Residential Advisors (1 per 10 students) for the duration of the program.
